

I have shown that Testimonies volume 9 pages 12 and 13 match the events of September 11, 2001. I have also shown that Manuscript Releases volume 14, pages 147-149 also match the same events. These two passages of Ellen White's writings are parallel. Now I will show that there is a third passage written by Ellen White which also parallels these same events.

Review and Herald, July 5, 1906 also predicts the events in New York City on September 11, 2001.

Let's look at the parallels between this and the other passages:

9t - "New York City"

rh - "New York"

9t - "lofty buildings"

14mr - "buildings"

rh - "great buildings", "massive structures"

9t - "story after story"

rh - "story after story"

14mr - "will be crumbled in the dust"

rh - "will be thrown down"

14mr - "the words of Revelation 18 will be fulfilled"

rh - "then the words of Revelation 18:1-3 will be fulfilled"

So what are the important characteristics that this passage tells us?

- An event will occur in New York City
- More than one building
- Called "great buildings"
- Will be thrown down by the turning and overturning of God's power.
- When this happens, there will be "terrible scenes"
- This happens when the Lord rises to shake terribly the earth.
- Revelation 18:1-3 will be fulfilled.

My conclusions are as follows:

- The events of September 11, 2001, marked the Lord rising to shake the earth.
- Then the angel of Revelation 18 came down and began giving his message.
- The voice of Revelation 18:4 has not been included yet.
- This is the beginning of the final crisis that will develop into the Sunday law crisis.
- God brought down the World Trade Center towers. It was done by his judgments.

“How comes the word that I have declared that **New York** is to be swept away by a tidal wave? This I have never said. I have said, as I looked at **the great buildings** going up there, **story after story**, ‘**What terrible scenes will take place when the Lord shall arise to shake terribly the earth! Then the words of Revelation 18:1-3 will be fulfilled.**’ The whole of the eighteenth chapter of Revelation is a warning of what is coming on the earth. But I have no light in particular in regard to what is coming on **New York**, only that I know that one day the **great buildings** there **will be thrown down** by the turning and overturning of God’s power. From the light given me, I know that destruction is in the world. One word from the Lord, one touch of his mighty power, and these **massive structures will fall.** Scenes will take place the fearfulness of which we can not imagine. {RH July 5, 1906, par. 14}
